

TO THE PERSON GIVING A JOB

Job Fortnight is a scheme whereby Cubs and Scouts are encouraged to earn, by their own efforts, a small sum towards the running costs and equipment needs of the Group to which they belong.

1. Please only offer a job which you believe the holder of this card will be competent to do. If you have a job which is beyond his/her capabilities, ask him/her to tell an older member of the Group.
2. Cubs and Scouts do not expect "something for nothing" and therefore it is requested that the payment made is a reasonable reflection of the effort expended.
3. When the job has been completed to your satisfaction, please, make an appropriate entry on the card.
4. Last but not least, THANK YOU for the encouragement of your support.

TO THE CUB OR SCOUT

1. Always wear FULL UNIFORM when you are seeking jobs. If you are offered a really "dirty" job it would be sensible to go home and change into old clothes.
2. As a Cub or Scout you will, of course, always be polite and a credit to your Group.
3. Only tackle those jobs which you are confident you can complete satisfactorily. If you are in any doubt pass the job onto an older Cub or Scout.
